*Directions: An annotated timeline displays a list of dates along with a brief summary detailing the significance of each date/event. Annotations should be relatively brief. The purpose of an annotated timeline is to condense information into small, manageable chunks.*

*Using the events listed below create an annotated timeline of the Reconstruction Era. The annotation should include the date of the event, a brief description of the event, and an explanation of its significance.*

*The timeline will **NOT** be proportional - meaning that events should be evenly spaced on the timeline although real time between events may vary greatly.*

### Events

Compromise of 1877

Freedmen's Bureau was created

Johnson issued his own "10 Percent Plus" Reconstruction Plan

Ku Klux Klan Act was passed

Lincoln Announced his "10 Percent" Plan for Reconstruction

Lincoln Vetoed the Wade-Davis Bill

Lincoln was assassinated

Mississippi passed the first Black Codes

President Johnson vetoed the Civil Rights Bill of 1866

President Johnson was impeached and acquitted

Radical Republicans gained a two-thirds majority in both houses of Congress

Tenure of Office Act was passed

The Fifteenth Amendment was ratified

The Fourteenth Amendment was ratified

The Ku Klux Klan was founded

The Reconstruction Act was passed
